Waste Materials Regulation – “P28”

The following Regulation is in accordance with the City of Brandon’s Fire Prevention By-Law #7200

Waste Materials

1. No person shall permit any accumulation of waste materials including but not limited to paper, hay, grass, straw, weeds, litter or combustible waste or rubbish of any kind to be or to remain upon any roof or in court, yard, vacant lot or open space. All weeds, grass, vines or other growth which may catch fire and endanger property shall be cut down and removed by the owner or occupier of the property on which they are located.
2. If an owner or occupier fails to comply with an Order to remove an accumulation of waste materials or cut down and remove any growth, the Authority Having Jurisdiction shall be authorized to carry out or cause to be carried out such removal at the cost of the owner or occupier. The owner shall pay the applicable fee prescribed in the City’s annual Fee Schedule By-law. If the owner or occupier cannot be located to pay this bill then all costs may be added to the real property taxes for the premises and collected in the same manner as normal taxes.
