Property-owners Self Declaration Form

The Education Property Tax Credit is a program which is administered by the Manitoba Tax Assistance Office as a department of Manitoba Finance. Property owners could be eligible for up to \$700, as an advance, to help cover the school taxes on their property tax bill. The information that is self-disclosed on this form will be provided to the Tax Assistance Office for the purpose of reviewing your eligibility in the program.
