

'BUILD A BRIDGE'

Exploring an Active Transportation / Pedestrian Connection at 8th Street



As per a decision of Brandon City Council, the current 8th Street Bridge structure will be demolished in the summer of 2017, with an active transportation/pedestrian corridor being pursued as a replacement to connect North End residents to Downtown Brandon. You are invited to be part of the conversation exploring the different attributes of a new connection. Some of the topics the City is looking for your feedback on include:

- **Length and Width of the Connection**
- **Accessibility Features**
- **Amenity Attributes**
- **Structure Design and Style**

Feedback from area property owners, stakeholders and the public at-large will be gathered at this exploration session and will help City of Brandon staff create a vision for the connection as 'built' by the community it will serve.
