



Education Property Tax Credit Advance (EPTCA) Property Owner Self Declaration Form

The Education Property Tax Credit is a program administered by the Manitoba Tax Assistance Office as a department of Manitoba Finance. Property owners could be eligible for up to \$700, as an advance, to help cover the school taxes on their property tax bill. If EPTCA is not received on the current years' property tax bill, the tax credit may be claimed via personal income tax return. To have the credit added to the next years' property tax bill, complete the self-declaration below and return to the City of Brandon, Property Taxes by April 15.
