PARK THEME: CULTIVATE DIVERSITY

AS PART OF THE PARK DEVELOPMENT A THEME IS BEING PROPOSED TO TIE THE ELEMENTS OF THE PARK TOGETHER AND CREATE A DESTINATION SPACE FOR THE PARK. BY USING THE COLOURS, SYMBOLS AND ARTISTIC EXPRESSIONS OF THE CULTURAL BACKGROUNDS OF HER NEIGHBOURHOOD THE CITY WIDE THEME OF CULTIVATE DIVERSITY IS CARRIED THROUGHOUT THE PARK IN THREE FORMS.

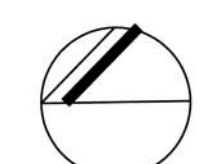
- BOLD PRIMARY COLOURS SEEN IN THE CEREMONIAL CLOTHES OF THE FIRST NATIONS AND OTHER NEIGHBOURHOOD DEMOGRAPHICS WILL BE USED FOR DECORATIVE ELEMENTS AND COLOURS FOR EQUIPMENT.
- THE PATTERNS OF THE ART AND SYMBOLS OF THE CULTURES WILL INFLUENCE THE FORMS OF THE STRUCTURES IN THE PARK. MURALS BY LOCAL ARTISTS CAN BE INSTALLED ON THE BUILDING WALLS REPRESENTING THE CULTURES.
- A LINKING THREAD OF ALL CULTURES IS THE IMPORTANCE OF FOOD. CORN AND OTHER GRAINS CAN BE USED AS SYMBOLS IN THE COLUMNS OF STRUCTURES AND BUILDINGS. NATIVE FOODS CAN ALSO BE ENCOURAGED AS A CROP IN THE COMMUNITY GARDEN AND ORNAMENTAL SPECIES OF GRAIN CROPS CAN BE USED IN PLANTINGS BY COMMUNITY GROUPS.
