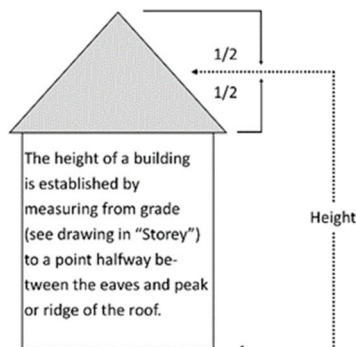


Building Elevation Plan Checklist

1. Title and date (latest revision)
2. Drawing scale (metric)
3. Location (civic address and/or legal description)
4. Exterior of the building (all sides of building), including but not limited to all windows, doors, loading bays, projections, decorative elements.
5. Exterior materials (e.g. brick, stucco, stone, hardy board, vinyl siding)
6. Height; measured from grade to the midway point of the peak of the roof (see sketch below).
If the grade varies across the site, please include the height at each corner of the building.
The average of the sum will be used to determine the building height.
7. For non-residential developments and where applicable, existing and proposed fascia sign, projection sign, awning/canopy, lighting fixtures, and other architectural/decorative elements on exteriors of building
