REGISTRATION FOR A BUFFER ZONE - NUISANCE MOSQUITOES

What is a buffer zone?

Residents can register with the City of Brandon Parks & Recreation Section in order to exempt their property during a Residential Adult Nuisance Mosquito Fogging Program. By registering a buffer zone, citizens will have their property and an area of **90 m** on either side of their property in the front street, side street and rear lane excluded from the Nuisance Mosquito Fogging Program. Residents are reminded that they must renew their buffer zone registration at the beginning of every season.

24-hour turnaround time is recommended for processing.
