## **INSPECTIONS FOR PART 9 – RESIDENTIAL OCCUPANCIES**

(All construction must comply with the Manitoba Building Code)

- 1. Once the footing forms are in place and before the footing is poured.
- 2. Once the foundation forms are in place and before the foundation is poured. In the case of a wood foundation, once the foundation is framed.
- 3. Moisture proofing and drain tiles prior to backfilling.
- 4. Grade beam forms prior to pouring.
- 5. Radon Gas Control prior to pouring basement floor.
- 6. Framing inspection prior to insulating.
- 7. Insulation inspection and vapour barrier inspection prior to installation of drywall.
- 8. Final inspection prior to occupancy Final inspections must be scheduled prior to occupying the building. Be sure to schedule final at least three (3) days in advance.

## The Plumbing inspections are as follows:

- 1. Ground work prior to backfilling
- 2. Above grade rough-in prior to insulation
- 3. Final prior to occupancy

## A MINIMUM OF 24 HOURS NOTICE MUST BE GIVEN PRIOR TO ANY INSPECTION.

Building inspectors are in the office from 8:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. to take appointments for inspections. When calling for an inspection, please be sure to have the proper **Address** and **Building Permit Number**. You may call your building inspector directly – Their number is list on your Building Permit Tracking Sheet.
