Lindsay is still working on getting funding from the community. Juno Award Winner Peter Puffin will be the musical keynote speaker for the children and provide two interactive workshop sessions. Throughout the week at city hall students projects will be displayed in the foyer with an afterschool reception on the Wednesday June 5 th . This event takes place during National Environment Week. 10	ACC fruit trees and other partnerships- Keith Williams informed the committee that ACC is thinking of developing a fruit orchard for teaching and research on the North Hill Campus. Shawn Hayden is a second year student who is researching this idea for his thesis. The objectives are to create a nursery with heritage fruit stock of Manitoba that is currently housed out of Morden. The hope is to have trees planted in 2014 with distribution in 2016 and to be planted throughout the community and be used by different groups within the city. There may be opportunity to develop a fruit share program and/or adopt a tree program. Doug made a motion that we as a committee send a letter of support for this project to ACC. Ryan seconded. ACC has also proposed a partnership with the city for the compost program. ACC would like to test the efficiencies of composts produced from different feedstock by the City of Brandon and to assess harvested produce quality parameters (external and internal indices) of the different crops grown in soils amended with the different composts.
