

# RETURN TO PLAY PROTOCOL

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## BRANDON'S COMMUNITY SPORTSPLEX

### GENERAL FACILITY GUIDELINES

The City of Brandon Sportsplex is committed to ensuring the health and safety of our patrons and staff. Current public health orders are in effect. Failure to comply with public health orders, or protocols as outlined below, may result in suspension of services. In addition to our general facility guidelines, you will find information specific to the Arena, Racquetball Courts, Multipurpose Room and Pool below.

#### Mask Usage

Mask usage throughout the Sportsplex facility is mandatory, with the following exceptions:

- A) A child who is under 5 years of age.
- B) A person with a medical condition that is unrelated to COVID-19, including breathing or cognitive difficulties, or a disability, that prevents them from safely wearing a mask.
- C) A person who is unable to put on or remove a mask without the assistance of another person.
- D) A person who needs to temporarily remove their mask while in an indoor public place for the purpose of
  - Consuming food or drink
  - An emergency or medical purpose
  - Or establishing their identity

#### HEALTH SCREENING

Health and safety of guests and employees is our number one priority. All patrons entering the facility are required to complete the self-screening questionnaire prior to arrival:

<https://sharedhealthmb.ca/covid19/screening-tool/> Individuals who do not pass the screening will be denied entry.

#### PHYSICAL DISTANCING & HAND SANITIZER

All employees and patrons must adhere to physical distancing guidelines by standing and/or sitting at least two meters away from other people throughout the facility. Distancing markers will be throughout the facility, located on floors and benches, indicating proper distancing.

Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the facility. Dispensers will be located at entrance and exit points, as well as high-contact and high-traffic areas. When entering the facility all patrons are required to utilize the hand sanitizer.

#### FACILITY MAINTENANCE & SANITIZATION

Protocols and procedures are in place to prevent the spread of COVID-19. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Restricted facility access;
- Signage to educate patrons of physical distancing and hand hygiene;
- Providing hand sanitizer throughout the facility;
- Increased frequency of cleaning in washrooms and high traffic areas;

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- Sanitization of dressing rooms and all benches between groups; and

### ARRIVAL/DROP OFF

Entrance to the building will be through the east (ramp side) doors and exit from the building will be specific to the facility activity patrons are taking place in. Directional signs throughout the facility must be adhered to at all times.

When entering the facility individuals will be greeted by a Sportsplex staff member to confirm the self-screening questionnaire has been completed. All individuals are required to utilize the hand sanitizer. Individuals must report directly to their designated area.

While waiting to enter the building, patrons must line up in the designated area while ensuring physical distancing.

### ARENA SPECIFIC GUIDELINES

#### GENERAL RULES

Access to the facility is limited to 15 minutes before and after the scheduled ice time. Failure to vacate the facility within the allocated time limit will result in an additional arena facility rate charge. A 15 minute arena charge will be invoiced for every 5 minutes patrons exceed their time limit.

All users must come fully dressed, minus helmets and skates.

On-Ice Capacity:

- Full Ice Rental - No more than 4 participants and 4 coaches on the ice per facility booking; and
- Half Ice Rental – No more than 2 participants and 2 coaches on the half ice section per facility booking.

Players and coaches may not swap places with other individuals throughout a facility booking.

All skaters must train individually, and ensure physical distancing from other skaters at all times. Each skater must be accompanied by one delegated coach. This coach may not provide instruction to any other skaters.

Dressing rooms are not be used for any purpose other than use of washroom facilities.

Absolutely no spitting. A zero tolerance policy regarding spitting will be enforced and individuals may be asked to leave the premises and have future bookings suspended.

All users must bring their own labeled, pre-filled water bottle. Sharing of water bottles is prohibited and no water fountains are available for participants or spectators.

Facility exit for players, coaches and officials is the lower level, west arena doors.

User names must be provided for all facility bookings prior to access to the facility. Names must include both the participant and the coach.

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### SPECTATORS

Spectators will be limited to **one** individual per on-ice participant receiving instruction. Spectators must report directly to a designated viewing area, with the exception of guardians who are assisting children with dressing. Spectators assisting children must report to designated viewing area immediately after children are dressed.

Washrooms directly off the viewing area are available for spectator use. Maximum of one individual per restroom.

Facility exit for spectators is through the front doors, as marked, or if players require assistance, the lower level, west arena doors.

### RACQUETBALL SPECIFIC GUIDELINES

#### GENERAL RULES

Access to the facility is limited to fifteen (15) minutes before and after the scheduled court booking.

All users must come dressed, minus shoes to be worn inside courts.

Players and coaches may not swap places with other individuals throughout a facility booking.

All players must train individually, within their designated court at all times. Each player must be accompanied by one delegated coach. This coach may not provide instruction to any other player.

Change rooms are not be used for any purpose other than use of washroom facilities.

Sharing of racquets, gloves or protective eyewear is prohibited.

Washrooms directly behind the front desk on the lower concourse are available.

Facility exit for players and coaches is through the front doors, as marked.

User names must be provided for all facility bookings prior to access to the facility. Names must include both the participant and the coach.

### SPECTATORS

Spectators will be limited to one individual per court booking.

Spectators must report directly to the racquetball viewing area on the upper concourse.

Washrooms directly behind the front desk on the lower concourse are available.

Facility exit for spectators is through the front doors, as marked.

## BRANDON'S COMMUNITY SPORTSPLEX MULTIPURPOSE ROOM, CLASSROOM & UPPER CONCOURSE GUIDELINES

### GENERAL RULES

These rooms are not currently open for bookings.

### AQUATIC SPECIFIC GUIDELINES

The aquatic facility is not open to the public at this time.
