In conjunction with the 2017 demolition of Brandon's former 8th Street Bridge structure, City Council tasked administration with the development of conceptual design options for an active transportation/pedestrian corridor to connect the City of Brandon's north end and downtown across the busy Canadian Pacific railway corridor.

After consideration of community feedback garnered at community meetings held in the spring of 2017 and with the assistance of Dillon Consulting, City administration has now finalized a number of design options that it feels best represents the safe, accessible and attractive connection sought by the community.

The City of Brandon's Development Services Division invites you to attend an open house on either the afternoon or evening of Thursday, May 17, 2018, where the various design options for this important linkage will be shared with the community.
