

## Conceptual Design Option 2 – Multi-Use Pathway on North Side of Pacific Avenue

Option 2 is to install a multi-use pathway on the north side of Pacific Avenue and to widen the sidewalk and boulevard space on the south side of the street. This option provides on-street parking on both sides of the street but reduces the opportunities for streetscape enhancements on the north side of the street and requires people biking and walking to share the pathway on the north side of the street which may reduce the safety and comfort of people accessing future businesses.

Other key features of this option include curb bump outs to improve pedestrian safety and comfort while crossing Pacific Avenue; enhanced landscaping along the corridor focused on the south side of the street; and streetscape amenities such as improved lighting, benches, and bike racks. Details of the elements recommended, such as, the type of trees, benches, and streetlights will be confirmed once the preferred option is selected.

This option balances the needs of all users along the corridor by providing a shared facility for people walking and biking on the north side of the street to accommodate on-street parking along both sides of the street.
