

COVID-19 Update for Public Hearings

Updated as of February 16, 2021

The City of Brandon has updated protective measures to maintain limited public access to City Hall set by the Government of Manitoba:

- Public hearings will continue to be held for land use applications, but we encourage the public to refrain from attending the public hearing
- We encourage the public to submit their comments or concerns by e-mail, and watch the meeting via the livestream at <https://www.youtube.com/user/CityofBrandonMB>
 - Contact the file manager indicated on the enclosed public notice prior to the public hearing to submit your comments
 - All comments or concerns will be provided to the Planning Commission to discuss at the hearing
- If you wish to attend the public hearing,
 - You **must contact the file manager** indicated on the enclosed public notice prior to the public hearing **to register to attend**
 - This will help us understand how many people will attend and prepare accordingly
 - **You must wear a mask inside City Hall**
 - We will not be supplying masks to the public
 - We will refuse entry if you do not have a mask or refuse to wear one while in City Hall
 - Upon entry,
 - You will be directed to thoroughly wash or sanitize your hands
 - There will be limited seating within the Council Chambers due to physical distancing requirements
 - Two-metre (six-foot) markers will be placed on the hallway floor indicating where people will be asked to stand
 - Staff will direct entry and exits from the Council Chambers and the building
