UNIT 2. POLICE VULNERABLE SECTOR VERIFICATION

This unit is to be completed by an individual applying for a position with a person or organization responsible for the well-being of one or more children or vulnerable persons, if the position is in a position of authority or trust relative to those children or vulnerable persons and the applicant wishes to consent to a search being made in criminal conviction records to be determined if the applicant has been convicted of a sexual offense listed in the schedule to the *Criminal Records Act* and received a record suspension.

Vulnerable Persons: A person who because of their age, a disability, or other circumstances, whether temporary or permanent, (a) are in a position of dependence on others; or (b) are otherwise at a greater risk than the general population of being harmed by a person in a position of authority or trust relative to them.

Part 2: Applicant's Consent to Conduct a Police Vulnerable Sector Search

I hereby consent to a search being made in the automated criminal records retrieval system maintained by the Royal Canadian Mounted Police to find out if I have been convicted of, and been granted a record suspension for, any of the sexual offenses that are listed in the schedule to the *Criminal Records Act*. I understand that, as a result of giving this consent, if I am suspected of being the person named in a criminal record for one of the sexual offenses listed in the schedule of the *Criminal Records Act* in respect of which a record suspension was granted or issued, I will be required to provide fingerprints to confirm that record and that record may be provided by the Commissioner of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police to the Minister of Public Safety and Emergency Preparedness, who may then disclose all or part of the information contained in that record to a police force or other authorized body. That police force or authorized body will then disclose that information to me. If I further consent in writing to disclosure of that information to the person or organization referred to above that requested the verification, that information will be disclosed to that person or organization.

The Police Information Check (PIC) will include the following information as it exists on the date of the search:

- Confirmation of declared criminal convictions from CPIC and/or local databases
- Summary convictions for 5 years, when identified by check of local Police service databases
- Findings of Guilt under the Youth Criminal Justice Act within the applicable disclosure period
- Outstanding entries such as Charges, Warrants, Judicial Orders, Peace Bonds, Probation Orders, and Prohibition Orders
- Absolute Discharges and Conditional Discharges within the applicable disclosure period (1 year for Absolute, 3 years for Conditional)

The Police Vulnerable Sector Check (PVSC) will include all of the above and the following information as it exists on the date of the search:

- All Record Suspensions or Pardons as authorized for release by the Minister of Public Safety and Emergency Preparedness
- In exceptional cases, non-conviction information (when it meets the Exceptional Disclosure Assessment) including but not limited to, Stayed, Withdrawn, Dismissed, and Not Criminally Responsible by Reason of Mental Disorder may be disclosed

The Brandon Police Service reserves the right to refuse to complete a Police Information Check/Police Vulnerable Sector Check.
