Please do not contaminate recycling or organic carts with these items; these belong in the garbage.



Rinse to remove food, liquid or product. Place loose in cart.



Newspaper, magazines & flyers

Plastic bottles & jugs

Plastic clam shell containers

Cereal boxes/cracker boxes



Plastic drinking bottles, cups & food containers



Milk, juice, soup cartons and boxes

Glass bottles & jars

Tin/aluminum food & drink cans

Cardboard (flattened)

No plastic or biodegradeable bags. Take food out of bags or containers.



Egg & seafood shells



Bread & baked goods



Soiled napkins, paper towels & paper plates



Vegetables, scraps & peels



Grass & weeds



Leaves



Pasta, rice, other grains



Fruits, cores, pits & peels



Coffee filters with grounds & tea bags







All empty oil and antifreeze containers accepted.












6:00 a.m.

PARK IT

Place your carts out by 6AM on your collection day. Ensure the carts are on flat ground.




SPACE IT

Leave 1ft of space between carts. Ensure 1.5ft from obstacles on either side like buildings or vehicles.



FILL IT

Lids should fully close. Excess material should not be placed over the rim or beside the carts.



STORE IT

Carts should be securely stored on your property after collection. Lost or stolen carts are your responsibility.

Accepted materials only in each cart.

Absolutely no metal, wood, bricks, trees, other construction or demolition materials, and special wastes.

Contamination of carts or failure to follow the above steps may result in no collection and/or subject to compliance violations per Solid Waste Collection and Disposal By-law 6965 and Compliance By-law 7198.
