

Updated Development Charges Rates

Development Charges (DC) have been in effect in the City of Brandon since July 1, 2019. They are charges imposed on new developments to recover capital costs associated with growth. Only those applying to develop a property pay these charges.

As part of the original DC By-Law, a regular review of the rates is required. Over a 16-month period between 2023 to 2024, the City of Brandon engaged Watson and Associates Economists Ltd. to support the City of Brandon in this process. The Development Charges Background Study is a comprehensive analysis of the future infrastructure needs and funding requirements to support the next 20 years of growth within the City of Brandon.

Currently, water and wastewater DCs are approved under the Public Utilities Board of Manitoba (PUB). It is estimated that the PUB approval process will take several months from the application submission date. Given this timeline, and to align capital infrastructure needs with updated DC rates, amendments to DC By-Law No. 7175 has been carried out through two sequential by-laws:

- The first amendment, By-Law No. 7397, includes updated rates for transportation and land drainage network infrastructure (passes by Council on April 7, 2025);
- The second amendment, By-Law No. 7406, addresses the remaining rates for water and wastewater treatment and network infrastructure (ongoing).

The following tables below summarize the current and upcoming DC rates for 2025, along with those proposed under By-Law 7406:

- **Rates as of January 1, 2025**: Consumer Price Indexing of 1.2% was applied to current rates approved under the original By-Law.
- **Rates as of June 6, 2025 (Following 1st Amendment)**: Includes new rates for land drainage and transportation network infrastructure as per By-Law No. 7397.
- Rates as of Enactment Date on PUB Board Order (Following 2nd Amendment): New rates for the remaining treatment and network Infrastructure. New rates under this amendment require PUB approval and third reading from Council.
- Phasing Schedule for High Density Residential Rates (Following 2nd Amendment): High density, water and wastewater DC rates are being recommended to be phased over a three-year period, with the phasing percentages of 25%, 50% and 100% only being applied to the proposed rate increase.
