

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR PUBLICLY-FUNDED SERVICES

- Manitoba Health Card
- Need for health services or assistance with daily activities to stay at home
- Require more help than existing community resources can provide
- Eligibility assessment completed by a PMH Home Care Coordinator

COST OF SERVICE

- No cost for publicly funded Home Care Services in Brandon except long-term respite care.
- There is a fee for service for private home care services.

(short in-home respite)
- **Respite Care**
(extended respite in a designated facility)

- **Physiotherapist/Occupational Therapist Assessment**

- **Home Support**
(e.g., meal prep, housekeeping, laundry)
- **Health Care Aide**
(e.g., mobility, bathing, toileting, dressing)
- **Companion Support**
(may include hospital accompaniment and pet care)

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SELF OR FAMILY MANAGED CARE OPTION

- Government funding is available to either self or family members for private home care services, as an alternative to public home care.
- Eligibility assessment is completed by a Home Care Coordinator to determine type and amount of service required
- Amount of funding provided is based on the assessment
