#### **Opinion**

We have audited the Public Sector Compensation Disclosure Report greater than or equal to \$75,000 of the City of Brandon (the "City") for the year ended December 31, 2022.

In our opinion, the accompanying Public Sector Compensation Disclosure Report of the City as at December 31, 2022 is prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with the criteria established by the terms and conditions of Section 2(1) of The Public Sector Compensation Disclosure Act.

#### **Basis for Opinion**

We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Public Sector Compensation Disclosure Report section of our report. We are independent of the City in accordance with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the Public Sector Compensation Disclosure Report in Canada, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

## Responsibilities of Management and Those Charged with Governance for the Public Sector Compensation Disclosure Report

Management is responsible for the preparation of the Public Sector Compensation Disclosure Report, in accordance with the criteria established by the terms and conditions of Section 2(1) of The Public Sector Compensation Disclosure Act, and for such internal control as management determines is necessary to enable the preparation of the Schedule of Employee Compensation that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.


Those charged with governance are responsible for overseeing the City's financial reporting process.
