DOORS OPEN AIMS TO PROMOTE VISITORS' KNOWLEDGE AND ENJOYMENT OF LOCAL HISTORY THROUGH THE EXPLORATION OF BRANDON'S BUILT HERITAGE



DALY HOUSE MUSEUM, BUILT IN 1882 IS THE LAST REMAINING PRE-1900 BUILDING ON 18TH STREET. SHARING THE HISTORY OF BOTH THE VICTORIAN ERA AND THE HISTORY OF BRANDON, OUR MUSEUM BOASTS A VARIETY OF COLLECTIONS IN FASHION, TECHNOLOGY AND ARCHITECTURE. COME VISIT OUR NEWEST EXHIBIT "WISH YOU WERE HERE: GREETINGS FROM BRANDON" AND WATCH AS WE GO FROM A SMALL FARMING COMMUNITY TO THE BUSTLING CITY WE KNOW TODAY!

SATURDAY AUGUST 16TH BRANDON ARMOURY 1116 VICTORIA AVE



ORIGINALLY CONSTRUCTED DURING THE FIRST WORLD WAR, THE FIRST FLOOR OF THIS BUILDING HOUSED THE ARMOURY WITH A LARGE DRILL HALL IN THE BACK.

OFFICE HEADQUARTERS WERE LOCATED ON THE SECOND FLOOR, AND THE CARETAKERS' ROOM ON THE THIRD. SINCE ITS CONSTRUCTION, THE ARMOURY HAS HOUSED MANY DIFFERENT GROUPS, INCLUDING XII MANITOBA DRAGOONS, AND THE 26TH FIELD REGIMENT RCA. SINCE 1978, THE FIRST FLOOR HAS BEEN OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS A MUSEUM, HONORING THE FALLEN SOLDIERS, SAILORS, AIR MEN AND WOMEN FROM THE BOER WAR TO THE WAR IN AFGHANISTAN.

THE PARISH ST AUGUSTINE OF CANTERBURY 327 4TH STREET




ST AUGUSTINE OF CANTERBURY CATHOLIC CHURCH WAS ESTABLISHED IN 1882, AS A SMALL FRAME CHURCH ERECTED JUST EAST OF THE PRESENT CHURCH. THE PRESENT CHURCH WAS BUILT IN 1903 AND IS OF NEO-GOTHIC DESIGN, PATTERNED AFTER THE GOTHIC STYLE OF THE 13TH CENTURY. THE CHURCH IS FILLED WITH SYMBOLS AND SYMBOLISM DISPLAYING IMPORTANT CONCEPTS ABOUT OUR THEOLOGY AND HISTORY. IN 2008 (THE 125TH ANNIVERSARY) A MAJOR REFURBISHMENT WAS UNDERTAKEN OF THE CHURCH'S INTERIOR UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF AN ECCLESIASTICAL ARTIST BY THE NAME OF JOSEF REIBESTEIJN FROM ONTARIO. PRESENTLY IT IS SERVED BY TWO PRIESTS WHO CELEBRATE DAILY MASS AS WELL AS 4 MASSES ON SUNDAY.

SATURDAY AUGUST 16TH 10:00AM - 4:00PM COMMONWEALTH AIR TRAINING PLAN MUSEUM 300 COMMONWEALTH WAY




THE COMMONWEALTH AIR TRAINING PLAN MUSEUM IS CANADA'S ONLY MUSEUM DEDICATED SOLELY TO THE STORY OF THE ROYAL CANADIAN AIR FORCE (RCAF) WHO TRAINED AND SERVED THE BRITISH COMMONWEALTH DURING WWII (1939-1945). TRAVEL TO THE 1940'S AS YOU WANDER THROUGH A VINTAGE HANGAR WHICH IS ALSO A NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE, AND SEE AIRCRAFT, VEHICLES AND HUNDREDS OF ARTIFACTS FROM THAT ERA. THE RCAF WWII MEMORIAL IS A 300 FOOT GRANITE WALL ETCHED WITH THE NAMES AND AGES OF OVER 19,000 FALLEN. IT IS CANADA'S ONLY PERMANENT PUBLIC MEMORIAL WHICH SERVES AS LASTING RECOGNITION OF ALL THE MEMBERS OF THE ROYAL CANADIAN AIR FORCE AND ALL CANADIANS SERVING IN ANY COMMONWEALTH AIR FORCE, WHO LOST THEIR LIVES DURING WORLD WAR II.

SATURDAY AUGUST 16TH BRANDON FIREHALL #1 120 19TH STREET NORTH



#1 FIRE HALL LOCATED AT 120-19TH ST. N WAS COMPLETED IN SEPTEMBER 2010. IT CURRENTLY HOUSES OUR OPERATIONS DIVISION THAT PROVIDES BOTH FIRE/EMS RESPONSE CREWS, SPECIALIZED RESCUE TEAMS, TRAINING & FIRE INSPECTION DIVISIONS, ADMINISTRATION STAFF, BRANDON PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATION CENTRE & SUPPORT STAFF AND THE CITY OF BRANDON'S EMERGENCY MANAGER. THE HALL HAS A MUSEUM WHICH SHOW CASES A BEAUTIFULLY RESTORED FIRE TRUCK THAT ONCE SERVED THE CITY OF BRANDON AS WELL AS MANY PIECES OF EQUIPMENT ONCE USED WITHIN THE FIRE DEPARTMENT. ADORNING THE WALLS OF THE HALLWAYS ARE PICTURES DEPICTING THE HISTORY AND EVENTS THAT TELL THE STORY OF OUR SERVICE. THE CORONATION BELL IS PROUDLY DISPLAYED IN OUR FRONT FOYER WITH INFORMATION PLAQUES EXPLAINING THE BELL'S HISTORY. THIS BELL WAS AT ONE TIME MOUNTED IN THE HOSE TOWER OF THE PREVIOUS #1 FIRE HALL AT 637 PRINCESS AVE.

SATURDAY AUGUST 16TH ART GALLERY OF SOUTHWESTERN MANITOBA 710 ROSSER AVENUE. UNIT 2



FOUNDED IN 1907, THE ART GALLERY OF SOUTHWESTERN MANITOBA IS THE PROVINCE'S OLDEST ART EXHIBITION AND TEACHING SPACE AND ONE OF CANADA'S FIRST. ORIGINALLY FORMED AS THE BRANDON ART CLUB, THEN THE ALLIED ARTS CENTER, BEFORE IT FINALLY ADOPTED ITS CURRENT TITLE IN 1989 AFTER SECURING A BUILDING ON 6TH AND PRINCESS, PREVIOUSLY A CO-OP FOOD STORE, AND TODAY THE AR MCDIARMID CIVIC CENTRE. IN 2000, THE CITY OFFERED TO MOVE THE AGSM INTO THE VACANT EATON'S BUILDING, WHERE IT IS STILL LOCATED TODAY. IT FEATURES TWO EXHIBITION SPACES, A GIFT SHOP WITH WORK FROM LOCAL MANITOBA ARTISTS, AND SIX STUDIOS THAT RUN ART SCHOOL PROGRAMS YEAR-ROUND TO TEACH PAINTING, PHOTOGRAPHY, CERAMICS, DRAWING, PRINT MAKING, PHOTOGRAPHY, AND MORE.

THE AGSM'S PHOTOGRAPHY DARKROOM WILL BE OPEN FOR TOURS AND A DISPLAY OF HISTORY AND ARTIFACTS WILL BE IN THE FOYER FOR VISITORS. BOTH GALLERIES WILL BE OPEN, SHOWCASING EXHIBITIONS:

THE ROYAL CANADIAN ARTILLERY MUSEUM-CANADA'S NATIONAL ARTILLERY MUSEUM-IS THE ONLY MUSEUM IN THE WORLD DEDICATED TO TELLING THE STORY OF THE MORE THAN 200,000 GUNNERS WHO HAVE SERVED CANADA. IT IS THE CENTRAL MUSEUM FOR THE ROYAL REGIMENT OF CANADIAN ARTILLERY, WHICH HAS BEEN PART OF CANADIAN HISTORY FOR 150 YEARS. IN 1962, THE CANADIAN FORCES ESTABLISHED THE RCA MUSEUM TO PRESERVE AND INTERPRET THIS PROUD HERITAGE FOR FUTURE GENERATIONS.

THE BRANDON MENTAL HEALTH CENTRE WAS ESTABLISHED IN 1891, AND THROUGH TIME A NUMBER OF VERY LARGE BUILDINGS WERE ADDED TO THE SITE, INCLUDING THE VALLEYVIEW BUILDING, PINERIDGE BUILDING, NURSES' RESIDENCE, AND PARKLAND BUILDING. THE NURSES' RESIDENCE AT THE BRANDON MENTAL HEALTH CENTRE WAS CONSTRUCTED IN 1921-23 WHILE THE OTHER MAJOR BUILDINGS AT THE SITE ARE HUGE, GRAND AND FORMAL, THE NURSES' RESIDENCE IS INFORMAL AND WELCOMING. THE SITE NOW BOASTS THE MANITOBA INSTITUTE OF CULINARY ARTS (MICA), HOUSED INSIDE A BEAUTIFUL HERITAGE BUILDING, COMBINING THE BEST OF BOTH NEW AND OLD.

BUILDING 1 (THE NURSE'S RESIDENCE/MICA) IS OPEN FOR VIEWING, PARKING IS AVAILABLE IN LOT 2 SEE MAP ON PAGE 7.



ST AUGUSTINE OF CANTERBURY CATHOLIC CHURCH WAS ESTABLISHED IN 1882 AS A SMALL FRAME CHURCH ERECTED JUST EAST OF THE PRESENT CHURCH. THE PRESENT CHURCH WAS BUILT IN 1903 AND IS OF NEO-GOTHIC DESIGN, PATTERNED AFTER THE GOTHIC STYLE OF THE 13TH CENTURY. THE CHURCH IS FILLED WITH SYMBOLS AND SYMBOLISM DISPLAYING IMPORTANT CONCEPTS ABOUT OUR THEOLOGY AND HISTORY. IN 2008 (THE 125TH ANNIVERSARY) A MAJOR REFURBISHMENT WAS UNDERTAKEN OF THE CHURCH'S INTERIOR UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF AN ECCLESIASTICAL ARTIST BY THE NAME OF JOSEF REIBESTEIJN FROM ONTARIO. PRESENTLY IT IS SERVED BY TWO PRIESTS WHO CELEBRATE DAILY MASS AS WELL AS 4 MASSES ON SUNDAY.
